Resolution 02-2026

The Town Board of the Town of Kildare, Juneau County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

A special charge to the property owners in the Town of Kildare, for the following services is made under s. 66.0627, Wis. stats.: Garbage/Refuse Disposal and Recycling.

Charges and costs, **\$115,025.87** incurred by the Town of Kildare for the above-described special services in 2025 shall be fully reimbursed and paid by the owners of a parcel with assessed improvements to the Town of Kildare by Oct 1, 2026. These special services were provided by the Town of Kildare or its agents on the following described real property in the Town of Kildare: Any parcel with assessed improvements or camper permits in the Town of Kildare, **548 total**.

If the full amount of the special charge is not timely paid by Oct 1, 2026, the unpaid special charge shall be considered delinquent and shall become a lien on the real property as of the date of delinquency and shall be included in the current or next tax roll for collection and settlement by the Town of Kildare under chapter 74, Wis. stats.

A public hearing was held April 21, 2026, and notice of public hearing were posted regarding this special charge.

The town clerk shall serve this resolution upon the landowner by posting on the website, clerk's office and town hall, as the town's notice to the landowners under s. 66.0627 (3) (a), Wis. stats.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Sec. 60.80 of Wis. Statutes within 30 days of the below noted adoption date.
